My dear parishioners,

I have some great news for our parish! Back in June, Lauren Gentry informed me that she had found another position as a campus minister, I immediately set about searching for a new youth minister. I trusted that the Lord would provide, but I also knew that many parishes were struggling to find one. A friend of mine who worked in Maryland told me that six parishes in her area were looking for one and had zero applicants. There is a website called Catholic-Jobs.com that I have used in the past and I immediately posted the job for a youth minister.

One of the things that happens when you post a job online, you sometimes get random and weird applicants. Sometimes from other countries, sometimes from people who just want a job and do not necessarily have the desire or credentials to fulfill the one you posted. After weeding out the ones you do not want, you start to see if the ones that look good are serious. I came back from vacation for a day to interview a few. The way I set it up was that I would do an interview first and then Lauren would then interview the candidate next and we would compare notes. What has been a rarity for me happened: the very first candidate we interviewed was the one we wanted. I am happy to announce our new youth minister is Ariana Andrade. Ariana was hired after a second interview with me and after I had made phone calls and inquiries on her references.

Ariana began on August 29 and will introduce herself on Sunday to all of you at the Masses. Ariana is a recent graduate of St. John's University where she was very involved with the campus ministry there. I truly believe Ariana is the right fit for our parish and she will build on the successes of our youth ministry programs. It is not just about resumes, I wanted someone who really loves Jesus and had a faith that inspires her to share that love with others. In her short time, Ariana has already been making connections with the youth and getting to know them.

I am very excited to have Ariana as a part of our team. Please make her feel welcomed and help her to get to know you as she begins her ministry at our wonderful parish. The Lord Jesus continues to make all things new at Blessed Virgin Mary, Help of Christians. Next week, I will have another exciting announcement.

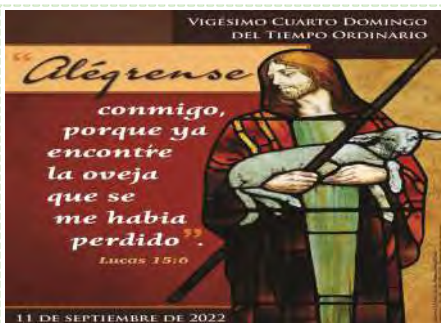

Sacred Scripture

101 In order to reveal himself to men, in the condescension of his goodness God speaks to them in human words: "Indeed the words of God, expressed in the words of men, are in every way like human language, just as the Word of the eternal Father, when he took on himself the flesh of human weakness, became like men."

102 Through all the words of Sacred Scripture, God speaks only one single Word, his one Utterance in whom he expresses himself completely: You recall that one and the same Word of God extends throughout Scripture, that it is one and the same Utterance that resounds in the mouths of all the sacred writers, since he who was in the beginning God with God has no need of separate syllables; for he is not subject to time.

103 For this reason, the Church has always venerated the Scriptures as she venerates the Lord's Body. She never ceases to present to the faithful the bread of life, taken from the one table of God's Word and Christ's Body.

104 In Sacred Scripture, the Church constantly finds her nourishment and her strength, for she welcomes it not as a human word, "but as what it really is, the word of God". "In the sacred books, the Father who is in heaven comes lovingly to meet his children, and talks with them."

101 En la condescendencia de su bondad, Dios, para revelarse a los hombres, les habla en palabras humanas: «La palabra de Dios, expresada en lenguas humanas, se hace semejante al lenguaje humano, como la Palabra del eterno Padre asumiendo nuestra débil condición humana, se hizo semejante a los hombres»

102 A través de todas las palabras de la sagrada Escritura, Dios dice sólo una palabra, su Verbo único, en quien él se da a conocer en plenitud «Recordad que es una misma Palabra de Dios la que se extiende en todas las escrituras, que es un mismo Verbo que resuena en la boca de todos los escritores sagrados, el que, siendo al comienzo Dios junto a Dios, no necesita sílabas porque no está sometido al tiempo

103 Por esta razón, la Iglesia ha venerado siempre las divinas Escrituras como venera también el Cuerpo del Señor. No cesa de presentar a los fieles el Pan de vida que se distribuye en la mesa de la Palabra de Dios y del Cuerpo de Cristo

104 En la sagrada Escritura, la Iglesia encuentra sin cesar su alimento y su fuerza, porque, en ella, no recibe solamente una palabra humana, sino lo que es realmente: la Palabra de Dios. «En los libros sagrados, el Padre que está en el cielo sale amorosamente al encuentro de sus hijos para conversar con ellos».
